

The List of Dual-Use Goods includes a wide range of goods that are designed for commercial applications but can have military applications or potentially be used as precursors or components of weapons of mass destruction.

A 5-digit alphanumeric code is used for goods and technology in the List of Dual-Use Goods. The list is divided into 10 categories and each category is further divided into 5 product groups.

The Category 3 (Electronics), Category 4 (Computers) or Category 5 (Telecommunications and "Information Security") of the List of Dual-Use Goods can be found in the Strategic Goods Control List in The Schedule to the Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2023.
