Note: as defined by EP IV:

- Category A - Projects with potential significant adverse environmental and social risks and/or impacts that are diverse, irreversible or unprecedented.
- Category B - Projects with potential limited adverse environmental and social risks and/or impacts that are few in number, generally site-specific, largely reversible and readily addressed through mitigation measures.
- Category C - Projects with minimal or no adverse environmental and social risks and/or impacts.
- Financial Close is the date on which all conditions precedent to the initial drawing of the debt have been satisfied or waived.
