


## **Tutorial 13: Spring Painting**

Step-by-step guide to create a plum blossoms and sparrow artwork using watercolours

In partnership with UOB Painting of the Year winning artists





Materials: Paper, Watercolours, Paintbrushes and Water






Prepare the watercolours.



Start by painting the plum blossoms in pink.






Paint some flower buds along with the plum blossoms in pink.






Paint the branches using black. The branches should get thinner as they branch out.



Draw a circle in the centre of the flower.



Paint details of the plum blossoms.



Paint the sparrow using brown.





Paint the sparrow's body and use strokes to paint its wings.



Paint the sparrow's tail using strokes.





Outline the sparrow's beak and neck in black. Add black spots on its body.





Paint the sparrow's eye.





Create another painting using watercolours.



## Three important tips:

- 1 Hold the paintbrush closer to the bristles for better control
- 2 Use the tip of the paintbrush to paint fine details
- 3 Dab the paintbrush on paper towel to remove excess water
